

To clear your local computer IP cache or DNS cache (to flush DNS) follow the below instructions.

To flush DNS cache on Windows XP/2000/2003:

- Click Start > Run or open command prompt
- Enter ipconfig /flushdns

in the textbox or in command prompt.

To clear your local DNS cache in Mac OSX:

- In Mac OSX Leopard, you can use the command `dnscacheutil -flushcache`
- To flush the DNS resolver cache enter: `bash-2.05a$ dscacheutil -flushcache`

In Mac OSX versions 10.5.1 and before, the command `lookupd -flushcache` performed the same task:

- Enter: `bash-2.05a$ lookupd -flushcache`

In combination with the above - you may need to reboot your computer and/or clear your browser cache.
