

To set all requests coming in to domain.com get redirected to www.domain.com follow the below instructions. http[://www. redirects are essential for good SEO of the website.

Create a .htaccess file with the below code. The .htaccess file needs to be placed in the root directory of your old website (i.e the same directory where your index file is placed)

**Options +FollowSymlinks**

**RewriteEngine on**

```
rewritecond %{http_host} ^domain.com [nc]
```

```
rewriterule ^(.*)$ http://www.domain.com/$1 [r=301,nc]
```

You need to replace the: domain.com and www.newdomain.com with your actual domain name.

Note\* This .htaccess method of redirection works ONLY on Linux servers having the Apache Mod-Rewrite moduled enabled.
